


Providing university admission policy analysis and all related information

President Information

This database provides information about presidents in 418 universities across Korea. Each data point includes academic and professional information of the president, as well as profile photos. In addition, general information about universities and their boards of directors is contained in the database

Faculty Recruitment

This platform provides brokers the faculty recruitment process. In addition to hiring professors, universities can use this platform to hire instructors and other types of faculty members

Contract Bidding

This commercial platform connects universities with businesses. Universities can register purchase or contract bidding notices at no cost, and businesses can access the information.

Introduction

The president summit found it's beginning in 2015 as a regular meeting for University and college presidents coming together to discuss and share ideas on furthering progress of higher education through a collective intellect which, in collaboration with policy makers and government, focused on 3 core themes < Improve Education Policy / Augment Education Boundaries / Strengthen Institutional Integrity>, in order to deal with the ever changing education environment that brought on the advent of MOOCs, Industry 4.0 paradigm shifts, the fall out of student numbers eligible for college and more.

Objective

With Industry 4.0 at hand, along with a falling birth rate and aging population, the education sector is in a state of rapid change where a financial distress for higher education institutions may occur. To deal with this impending change, the importance of nurturing creative minds that can adapt to these changes is paramount. UCN Educational Trip to Arizonal State University

The destination for the UCN Overseas Benchmarking Trip 2019 was Arizona State University (ASU), which was selected as the most innovative university in the United States for four consecutive years. The goal of the trip was to find ways to introduce and effectively implement the adaptive learning system developed by ASU to the Korean education system, in addition to analyzing implications of the American case for Korean university education.



Junior College Summit in Tokyo Conference (Japan)
